THE QUESTION

How can we bring Catholics back?

While the overwhelming majority of our children are receiving First Communion and Confirmation, 15% of their parents are attending weekly Mass! We must find ways to reach out to these "fallen-away" and "marginally" Catholic adults and lead them back to the fullness of faith (while also seeking to feed all of our adults).

The problem is not generally a lack of catechesis. Most of these individuals were well instructed in the faith in their youth and there is a treasure of adult faith formation



STEP 1 - EVANGELIZE

Through a powerful, life-changing single day of renewal


Add the God Is! Day of Renewal to your parish Sacramental preparation curriculum with the expectation that at least one parent will attend. And, invite other interested adults to attend as well. Presented by parish volunteers on a Saturday, God Is! lovingly and effectively re-proposes the faith. It both explains and promotes the importance of Mass and the other Sacraments. It makes the Church "relevant" and promotes community. Through talks, personal witness, small group discussion, Sacramental renewal, and Mass, God Is! invites hard hearts to soften and convicted hearts to grow even closer to God.



STEP 2 - CATECHIZE

Through modern media for easy, ongoing faith formation

In partnership with Lighthouse Catholic Media, Evangelize All Ministries provides participants of God Is! a set of free CDs. Participants can avail themselves of these effective tools of inspiration and formation at their convenience (e.g. while commuting or carpooling). Evangelize All Ministries also sends out a short monthly "Epistle" (email newsletter) that supports adults in their faith journey and offers tools for personal spiritual growth.
